

GD no. 966 from of September 15, 2010 on the access rights for the Romanian public authorities to the National Information System for Alerts

Based on art. 108 of the Romanian Constitution, republished and on art. 5 paragraph (1) of Law no. 141/2010 on setting up, organizing and functioning of the National Information System for Alerts and participating of Romanian to the Schengen Information System,

The Romanian Government adopts the present decision.

Art. 1

The present decision sets up the Romanian public authorities' access rights to the National Information System of Alerts, hereinafter named NISA.

Art. 2

According to the present decision, the below terms have the following meanings:

- a) entering – to input data in NISA originated from own databases, to modify and delete this data, as well as query in order to modify or delete it;
- b) querying – analyzing the elements foreseen in the NISA alerts.

Art. 3

The Romanian public authorities who have access rights to the NISA are:

- a) Romanian Police;
- b) Romanian Border Police;
- c) Romanian Gendarmerie;
- d) Romanian Immigration Office;
- e) Directorate for Persons' Records and Management of Databases;
- f) Passports General Directorate;
- g) Directorate for Driving Licenses and Vehicles Registration Certificates;
- h) National Customs Authority;
- i) Ministry of Foreign Affairs;
- j) Ministry of Justice and Courts of Justice;
- k) Public Ministry.

Art. 4

The categories of alerts as well as the transactions to which the public authorities established at art. 3 have access to, according to the provisions of law. No 141/2010 on setting up, organizing and functioning of National Information System for Alerts and

participation of Romania to the Schengen Information System, are foreseen in the annex within the present decision.

Art. 5

The Romanian Police and the Romanian Border Police are nominated as competent national authorities to provide data specific to alerts foreseen at art. 15 paragraph (1) and art. 18 paragraph (1) within Law no. 141/2010.

Art. 6

The Romanian Police, by SIRENE Bureau, is nominated as national competent authority to provide data specific to alerts foreseen at art. 16 paragraph (1) within Law no. 141/2010.

Art. 7

The authorities which issue the documents foreseen at art. 18 paragraph (2), letters d) and e) within Law. No 141/2010, notified to be stolen abroad, are nominated as national competent authorities to provide data specific to alerts regarding those documents.

Art. 8

The institutions of the judiciary system provide data set in the annex, according to the provisions of art. 5 paragraph (3) within law. No 141/2010.
